Dear Prof. Johnson:

As part of building a stronger curriculum at both institutions, we would like to make available a wealth of course materials that you may use in your classrooms at Langston, or to provide training for your faculty, without formally registering for the relevant courses at OSU.

Because of the close ties between the M.S. in Telecommunications Management (MSTM) program and the Center for Telecommunications and Network Security Management (CTANS), we can offer all materials, including lecture notes, powerpoint slides and even electronic video captures of every class session for TCOM-prefixed courses that have been offered in the past year. This includes the majority of the graduate security curriculum at OSU.

Although you may access all of these materials, we must approve use of the video portion in your classes on an individual basis. This is due to copyright issues with OSU's Extension Division. For faculty training and course preparation, however, use of video materials is unrestricted. Copyright is retained by OSU.

Additionally, we will facilitate use of any other classes in the area of information assurance that you believe may be of use in further developing the security program at Langston, and coordinating the background of Langston undergraduates such that they may succeed in OSU's graduate programs in IA. These courses will likely come from Computer Science or Electrical and Computer Engineering, but may be in other departments as well.
